The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.500, dated 26.11.2018, lodged under Sections 315 and 323 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Sahlawas, District Jhajjar, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it is a case of the petitioner that neither was she named in the FIR in question nor any injury attributed to her. In fact, the FIR in hand was a counter blast to FIR No.498 dated 26.11.2018 which was lodged by her nephew against the complainant herein (Ravi Kumar) and his brother (Anand) under Section 376, 452, 354 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Salhawas, District, Jhajjar and in that case, the petitioner was a prosecution witness.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 07.05.2019, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gajraj Singh, states that the petitioner is no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the aforesaid, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 07.05.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
