This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.5 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that petitioners have already made representation on 23.06.2021 to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab Police Headquarters, Sector-9, Chandigarh, respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran and respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali), copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/1, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran and respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali) to look into and decide representation dated 23.06.2021 (Annexure P/1) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
