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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner is a widow. Her grievance is that respondents No. 4 and 5 had taken her tractor for using it for sometime. However, they have not returned the tractor despite repeated requests. Petitioner states that respondents No. 4 and 5 are retaining the tractor because they have some monetary dispute with her son. However, she has no concern with her son and respondents No. 4 and 5 are unjustified in retaining the tractor on that account. The tractor is the only source of her livelihood. Repeated panchayats have been taken to respondents No. 4 and 5, but to no avail. Despite representation dated 12.5.2020 (Annexure P-1) having been submitted to respondent No. 2 (Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda), no action has been taken thereon.

Learned counsel for petitioner states that he would submit a fresh representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda and Station House Officer, P.S. Dyalpura, District Bathinda (respondents No. 2 and 3) for listing out her grievance.

Without in anyway commenting anything on the merits of case and opining on the veracity of allegations of petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to look into representation of petitioner and take such action as may be warranted in law.
