By this petition, filed under the provisions of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents no.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner in the hands of respondents no.5 and 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after this petition was filed, there has been no threat to the life of the petitioner but as regards his grievance, the representation made by him to the SSP, Police District, Batala, dated 18.06.2021 (copy Annexure P-5), has not been acted upon at all.

Without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the SSP, Police District Batala, to go into the matter and to take action as may be warranted as per law,

within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
