The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 100 dated 05.04.2013, under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and he had been wrongly declared as a 'proclaimed offender'.

Heard.

The FIR was registered against the petitioner in the year 2013. The petitioner had been declared as a 'proclaimed offender' vide order dated 24.07.2018. The allegations against the petitioner are that he had duped the complainant of ₹20,00,000/-, as his property was sold by his impersonation.

In the facts and circumstances, especially when the petitioner has been declared as a 'proclaimed offender', I do not deem it to be a fit case to

grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.

However, it is clarified that nothing which has been observed here-in-above shall be deemed to have any bearing on the merits of the case.
