Petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0058 dated 17.06.2021, under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC (offence under Sections 452, 354-A IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Sadar Nawanshahar, District SBS Nagar.

In pursuance to order dated 13.07.2021, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he has brought a Demand Draft No.720900 dated 01.11.2021 of Rs.15000/- in favour of respondent No.2-Neetu Bhatia. Same is handed over to the learned Counsel for the complainant today in the Court.

By virtue of the order dated 13.07.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the same, the interim order dated 13.07.2021, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
