The petitioner in the present writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeks promotion to the post of TGT English/Sanskrit, on the ground that he is duly eligible and entitled for the same from the date when his junior Anil Kumar was promoted on 04.01.2021 w.e.f. 17.07.2018, as per Annexure P-13.

It is the grouse of the petitioner's counsel that vide order dated 02.08.2018 (Annexure P-13/A) persons mentioned at Serial No.53 and 173 have also been promoted to the post of TGT English in District Kaithal, who were junior to the petitioner.

Counsel has brought to the notice of the Court the table mentioned in para no.14 of the petition to show that the petitioner was appointed as JBT/PRT on 14.07.2004 and abovesaid persons have been appointed thereafter. It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that demand notice dated 09.04.2021 (Annexure P-15) has also been served upon the respondents and he would be satisfied if the same is decided in a time bound manner.

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Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Kumar Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Keeping in view the limited controversy as such and since the decision making is still incomplete, no useful purpose will be served to call upon the respondents for filing reply, as it would cause further delay in deciding the proceedings.

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case or entitlement of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to the respondents to take a decision on the above said demand notice dated 09.04.2021 (Annexure P-15) within a period of 3 months from the receipt of the certified copy of this order. The competent authority shall take into consideration the averments made in the writ petition, especially the table mentioned in the petition. In case the relief is to be denied, reasoned order be passed and communicated to the petitioner.
