The petitioner in the present writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeks directions for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents for considering the petitioner for the post of BPEO and Principal in the category of Persons with Disability in place of General Category as shown the Admit Card issued by respondent No.1-Commission.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has applied with the respondent No.1 for three posts in question i.e. BPEO, Head Mistress and Principal. The petitioner is stated to be a handicapped person as per certificate (Annexure P-9). For the post of Head Mistress, she has been treated as a handicapped person having locomotive disability, whereas for the other posts she has been treated as a General Category candidate, as per admit card (Annexure P-6). It is further submitted that legal notice dated 22.06.2021 (Annexure P-13) has also been served upon the respondents, for the said relief.

Keeping in view the above, this Court is of the opinion that the respondent No.1 shall take into consideration the legal notice dated 22.06.2021 (Annexure P-13) and decide as to under which category the petitioner is to be considered, keeping in view the fact that there is a common admit card as such. In case, the claim is not admissible, reasoned order be passed and communicated to the petitioner.
