This is an application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for adding the Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC in the bail application alongwith other Sections mentioned in the same being added by the Police lateron.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed.

**CRM-M No.27042 of 2021**

The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail on behalf of the Petitioner in case FIR No.89, dated 08.05.2021, registered under Sections 188 and 269 IPC; Section 61 of Excise Act; and Section 51-B of Disaster and Management Act at Police Station Bhauna, District Fatehbad.

2. The petitioner has been in detention for 87 days by now.
3. Ld. Counsel for the State submits that challan against him has already been prepared and is likely to be filed in the Court within the next 1-2 days. All the offences for which the petitioner has been involved in are triable by the Court of Magistrate. Custodial interrogation of the petitioner at this stage is admittedly not required in the interest of investigation.
4. In the circumstances, without commenting upon the other merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial is likely to take a considerable time to conclude in view of the on-going Covid-19 Pandemic, at this stage, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the Petitioner for an indefinite period is not justified. As such, he is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
