Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.61 dated 06.04.2021 under Sections 22 and 29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act registered at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur Punjab.

As per the allegations in the FIR, 1000 intoxicant tablets Tramadol Hydrochloride labelled as Celcidal 100-SR lying in 100 strips having 10 tablets each were recovered from co-accused namely Passo. The name of the petitioner has surfaced on the disclosure statement of Passo, who allegedly stated that the said intoxicant tablets have been supplied to her by the petitioner.

The petitioner is in custody since 10.05.2021. Her name has surfaced in the disclosure statement of the co-accused.

The trial is unlikely to conclude in near future more so in

the wake of outbreak of pandemic COVID, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner-Jailo Kaur is ordered to be released on bail subject to her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Chief Judicial Magistrate, concerned.

It has come on record that the petitioner is involved in three other NDPS cases. It is made clear that in case the petitioner indulges in any similar activity while on bail, the prosecution agency will be at liberty to seek the cancellation of the order granting bail to the petitioner.
