AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This is a second petition for anticipatory bail in FIR No. 236 dated 7.5.2021, under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station, Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

In the earlier petition, on advance notice, learned counsel for the State of Punjab raised an objection that the petitioner had not approached the court with clean hands as he had already filed a petition for anticipatory bail and the said fact was not disclosed in the petition. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that she was not given instructions of earlier petition, she apologized and sought permission to withdraw the petition.

Considering the apology rendered, without recording reasons, permission was granted to withdraw the petition.

Now a second petition is filed seeking anticipatory bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner without arguing further and realising the facts, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
