The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.117 dated 15.07.2015, under Sections 21, 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had earlier been granted interim bail for want of FSL report in view of the judgment of the Division Bench of this Court in the case of **Inderjit Singh @ Laddi Vs. State of Punjab**, 2014 (3) RCR (Criminal) 953. The FSL report has been received and the recovered substance has been found to be 250 grams Diphenoxylate.

Heard through video conferencing.

As per the FSL report, the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner is found to be 250 grams Diphenoxylate which is above the threshold of 50 grams as commercial quantity. Therefore, the petitioner is not entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail and the petition stands dismissed.
