The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case General Diary No.41 dated 17.03.2021 under Sections 323, 148 and 149 IPC (Sections 341 and 308 IPC added lateron) registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot in FIR No.42 dated 17.03.2021 registered under Sections 452, 354, 379-B, 323, 148 and 149 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits it is a case of version and cross-version wherein both the parties were involved in a scuffle over a piece of land measuring 3 kanals 19 marlas. It has also been submitted that in the occurrence in question both the parties received injuries at the hands of each other. Learned counsel submits that in compliance of order dated 12.07.2021, passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating officer.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Chamkaur

Singh, does not dispute the factum of the petitioners having joined investigation and submits that the petitioners are not required for further investigation much less custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 12.07.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
