The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.844 dated 29.08.2018 under Section 436 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Sirsa.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner does not want to press the present petition and he has instructions to state that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and join the proceedings as the petitioner has declared as a proclaimed offender on 13.01.2020.
