Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to join his services as Sewadar in the office of respondent No.3 i.e. Zila Parishad, Bathinda, in compliance of order dated 19.05.2021 and also to pay the salary for the intervening period.

At the outset, it is pointed out by learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, that although, he has been allowed to join his duties but salary is not being paid for the intervening period and his legal notice dated 07.06.2021 (P-7) is pending for consideration. Further submits that at this stage, his client would be satisfied in case, legal notice dated 07.06.2021 (P-7) is considered and decided by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present through video-conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 and 2, whereas, Mr. Nakul Sharma, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.3. Learned counsel for the respondents raise no objection to the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the consensus arrived at between both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 07.06.2021 (P-7), in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of six weeks from today.
