The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

While issuing notice of motion on 24.08.2021, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Through this petition the petitioner (ex-wife of respondent) prays for the transfer of the petition filed by her under Section 7/25 of the Guardians & Wards Act, 1890, read with Section 6 of the Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act, 1956, titled as 'Parneet Kaur vs. General Public and another' pending in the Court of Guardian Judge-cum-Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kapurthala to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.

The petitioner claims that she was earlier married to the respondent and a daughter was born from their wedlock. A decree of divorce was granted on 29.05.2020 and as per the settlement, the daughter is residing with the petitioner.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that now the petitioner has got married to Yashwinder Singh and at present, she alongwith her minor daughter, is residing with Yashwinder Singh at Ludhiana. He further contends that the petitioner cannot properly defend the petition at District Court Kapurthala as the distance between Ludhiana and Kapurthala is 70-80 kms.

Notice of motion for 10.09.2021.

The liberty is granted to the petitioner to serve the respondent through his counsel in District Court, Kapurthala.

*Dasti* also.”

Sh.Avtar Singh Khinda, Advocate, has entered appearance on behalf of the respondent and has contested the petition. Neither a reply controverting the facts has been filed nor the facts were confuted in the arguments.

In view of the aforesaid, the transfer application is allowed. It is directed that the proceedings in the petition filed under Section 7/25 of the Guardians & Wards Act, 1890, read with Section 6 of the Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act, 1956, titled as 'Parneet Kaur vs. General Public and another' pending in the Court of Guardian Judge-cum-Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kapurthala be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana. The transferor court is directed to remit the file of the case to the transferee court forthwith. The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the District & Sessions Judge, Ludhiana on 07.10.2021, who would either try the case himself or assign the same to the court of competent jurisdiction in the District.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
