Prayer in the instant petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to afford an opportunity to the petitioner to swap the category from 'General' to 'Economical Weaker Section' as the same was inadvertently filled as 'General' at the time of submission of online application due to technical snag.

On previous occasion i.e. 02.08.2021, the following order was passed:-

“Learned State counsel, on instructions from Surinder Singh, Senior Assistant, Office of Education Recruitment Board, Punjab, has apprised the Court that representation (annexure P-4) has already been considered and rejected vide order dated 21.07.2021.

Since no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner, purely in the interest of justice, adjourned

to 09.08.2021.”

It seems that learned counsel for the petitioner has lost interest in pursuing the matter.

Consequently, writ petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
