Petitioners are praying for direction to respondents No.2 and 3
to provide protection to their life and liberty from the hands of private
respondents No.4 to 10.

In the petition, it has been stated that both the petitioners are
into live-in-relationship which has been opposed by private respondents
No.4 to 10 including respondent No.7-Pardeep Kumar who is husband of
petitioner No.1.

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that as the petitioners
are apprehending threat from the side of the aforesaid private respondents,
they gave representation dated 6.7.2021 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2

representation., Counsel for the petitioners further submitted that he will be satisfied if necessary action is taken by the authorities on the basis of the aforesaid representation.

Mr. Arun Kaundal, DAG, Punjab appearing for the official respondents submits that in case any such representation is pending, the concerned authority will look into the matter and take action in accordance with law.

In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali to consider representation dated 6.7.2021 (Annexure P-5) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the relationship of the petitioners. It is also made clear that respondent No.7-Pardeep Kumar is at liberty to avail appropriate legal remedy in accordance with law against the petitioners.,
