This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic, COVID-19.

Grievance raised by the petitioner is that his application/representation dated 18.01.2021 (Annexure P-10) seeking pension under 'the Haryana State Shubhra Jyotsna Pension and other Facilities Scheme, 2018' is not being considered though both the petitioner and his father (since deceased) had suffered imprisonment under the MISA Act, 1971 and the present petitioner is entitled to monthly pension under the above said Scheme (Annexure P-1).

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts the prayer for a final decision on the application/representation dated 18.01.2021 (Annexure P-10), in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Sharan Sethi, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of both the respondents. Advance copy of the writ petition stands served. Learned counsel for the State does not raise any serious objection to the limited prayer addressed.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, but without any expression of opinion on the merits of the matter, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to consider and decide the application/representation dated 18.01.2021 (Annexure P-10), within a period of three months from receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
