This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail has been moved by petitioner in Cross Version DDR No.43 dated 16.06.2017 under Sections 148, 323, 324, 326 and 506 IPC read with Section 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur, arisen out of FIR No.89 dated 15.06.2017 under Sections 148, 323, 324, 326, 341 and 506 IPC read with Section 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

Reply dated 23.08.2021 by way of affidavit of Paramjit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, Dhuri, already filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.
