JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No.267 dated 27.06.2021, under Sections 306/34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Kotwali, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from her.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Investigating Officer, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not

required for the custodial interrogation. In fact, she has been found innocent.

At this stage, counsel for the complainant would submit that the petitioner is still withdrawing money from the bank account of the deceased.

In such a situation, let an appropriate application be filed by the complainant to the SSP, Patiala, who will look into the application filed by the complainant in accordance with law.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 23.07.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
