Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

By this petition, petitioner is seeking permission to go to USA for a reasonable time on medical emergency condition and on emergent Visa issued by USA Embassy during the pendency of case FIR No.11 dated 24.01.2020, under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC, at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.
