Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.200 dated 19.05.2021 registered under Sections 406, 420 and 506 IPC at Police Station Industrial Sector 29, Panipat, District Panipat.

Vide order dated 14.07.2021 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted *ad-interim* anticipatory bail and directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 14.07.2021 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Rajesh Kumar, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is now not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 14.07.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
