Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for extension of interim bail granted to the petitioner in case FIR No. 96 dated 05.05.2021, under Sections 307, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa Haryana.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Vishal Malik, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent/State.

The petitioner is accused in FIR No. 96 dated 05.05.2021, under Sections 307, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa Haryana. He filed an application for release on interim bail on the ground that his wife had tested COVID positive and that she has sustained a bullet injury. Vide order dated 25.05.2021 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sirsa, the petitioner was granted interim bail till 30.06.2021. During this period the wife of the petitioner unfortunately died due to

the injury sustained by her and the petitioner also tested COVID positive. Thereafter, an application for extension of interim bail was filed. Vide order dated 05.07.2021, the interim bail granted to the petitioner was extended till 12.07.2021. He was directed to surrender before the Court on 13.07.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has not fully recovered from COVID.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted to the petitioner by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sirsa is extended for a period of three weeks i.e. till 03.08.2021. The petitioner shall surrender himself before the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate on 04.08.2021 at sharp 10:00 am.

Disposed of accordingly.
