The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to
Covid-19 pandemic.

On 10.05.2019, the following orders were passed:-

*“Through this petition under Section 438
Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory
bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 268 dated
10.10.2018 registered under Section 380 IPC at Police
Station Kharar City, Kharar.*

*According to the prosecution, on 13.08.2018, the
petitioner along with his accomplice took forcible
possession of showroom No. 18, Bansa Wali Chungi,
Kharar, from the complainant by breaking open the locks
and stolen his articles lying therein.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia
contends that the petitioner is neither the owner nor has
any relation, connection or interest in the demised
premises.*

Notice of motion for 13.09.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when called by the Investigating Officer. In the event of arrest, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. He shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, upon instructions, from ASI Lakhwinder Singh submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no longer required.

In view of the above fact, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Order dated 10.05.2019 is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
