The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.127 dated 14.04.2021 under Sections 13(1), 13(2) of the Haryana Gauthansh Sanrakshan and Gauthamvardhan Act, 2015 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that two cows chained in a vehicle were being transported. He, however, contends that there is no allegation that there were any injuries on the cows. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for over three months and is not involved in any other criminal case.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Om Parkash, states that although challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the above especially when the petitioner is in custody for over three months, the Covid-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
