This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved by petitioner for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7 and to take action on representations dated 30.03.2021 and 07.06.2021 (Annexures P-9 and P-10).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representations on 30.03.2021 and 07.06.2021 to Commissioner of Police, Gurugram and Assistant Commissioner of Police (West/Old), Gurugram, copy of which are available on the file as

Annexures P/9 and P/10, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Manish Dadwal, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 – Commissioner of Police, Gurugram, to look into and decide representations dated 30.03.2021 and 07.06.2021 (Annexures P/9 and P/10) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within eight weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
