Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved by petitioner for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to transfer investigation of complaints bearing No.1965 SSP Hoshiarpur dated 11.11.2020, complaint bearing No.2260 SSP dated 03.07.2021 and complaint No.2587 P.D. dated 17.06.2021 filed by respondents No.8 to 10 against the petitioner, to a Senior Police Officer or any (IPS Officer) outside Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that petitioner has not made any representation to the authorities concerned. He further submits that present petition may be treated as representation and respondent No.3 – Inspector General of Police (Jalandhar Range), District Jalandhar, is directed to look into the matter

and decide the same, in accordance with law.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 7 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 7. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3 – Inspector General of Police (Jalandhar Range), District Jalandhar, to treat the present petition as representation and look into and decide the same in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within four weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
