The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C., for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.41 dated 17.03.2021 under Sections 341, 323, 148, 149 (Section 341 & 308 added later on) IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot (cross case in FIR No.42 dated 17.03.2021 under Sections 452, 354, 379-B, 323, 148 and 149 IPC)

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the said matter. It is also submitted that the matter has been investigated and the challan has been presented and trial is likely to take some time to conclude, therefore, custody of the petitioner would no longer be required.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State opposes the grant of regular bail referring to the allegations but is not in a position to dispute the fact that there is no medical on the record and that there is a delay in registering of the FIR.

I have heard counsel for the parties and have also perused case file.

In view of the aforesaid factual position and the facts that the matter stands investigated; challan has been presented and the co-accused has been allowed regular bail, I deem it appropriate to allow the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner. The petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
