[1] The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

[2] This petition in the nature of Habeas Corpus is filed for the release of detainee (name withheld) aged 17 years and 11 months from illegal confinement of private respondents arrayed in the petition.

[3] A Warrant Officer was appointed on 13th July, 2021. Report received of the Warrant Officer in a stappled envelope is opened and taken on record.

[4] As per the report, the detainee was not found on the places pointed out by the petitioner or at the residence of private respondents.

[5] From the pleadings it is forthcoming that there is an apprehension that the detainee had eloped with respondent No.4 to solemnize marriage. Petitioner got FIR registered against respondent No.4.

[6] Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that liberty be granted to pursue the remedy available in accordance with law including to pursue the FIR.

[7] Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
