1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of order dated 12.07.2021 having been passed by the respondent in terms of order dated 18.05.2021 in CRWP No.4538 of 2021, the petitioners do not wish to pursue the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such by granting liberty to the petitioners to challenge order dated 12.07.2021.

3. In view of the position noted above, there is sufficient compliance with order dated 18.05.2021 in CRWP No.4538 of 2021, therefore, no action is required to be initiated against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

4. Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as such, while granting liberty to the petitioners to challenge order dated 12.07.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
