This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.147 dated 26.07.2020 under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur. The petitioner apprehend his arrest at the hands of Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 07.08.2020, whereby the interim protection was extended to the petitioner. He contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioner submitted himself before the Police and joined the investigation and the matter also stands compromised with the complainant/Bank. According to him, the petitioner cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by ASI Jaswinder Singh does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation. He

further states that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 07.08.2020 is made absolute.
