The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* by directing the respondents No. 1 and 2 to consider the claim of the petitioner for grant of arrears of pay scale and allowances for higher post as the petitioner discharged his duties and responsibilities on the higher post with further directions to grant the retiral benefits and fixation of pension, for which, a legal notice dated

17.03.2021 (Annexure P-10) has also been served upon the respondents.

In the light of oral submissions of the petitioner side the directions are issued to respondents to duly consider the legal notice dated 17.03.2021 (Annexure P-10) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.
