The petitioner, *inter alia*, seeks a direction to the respondents to confer upon him deemed date of promotion to the post of ASI w.e.f. 13.05.2011 when his juniors were promoted.

Notice of motion in this case was issued on 15.07.2021.

Today on the resumed hearing of the case, learned State counsel has handed over a copy of the order dated 15.09.2021 passed by the ADGP, Technical Services, Punjab. A perusal of the same would show that the petitioner has been shown at Sr.No.884 and placed senior to ASI Sarabjit Singh (Sr.No.888) and as such, the petitioner has been granted deemed date of promotion as ASI w.e.f. 16.01.2015. In this view of the matter, learned counsel for the State submits that the writ petition has become infructuous.

This Court finds that since substantive relief has already been granted to the petitioner, no further orders are called for. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to move a representation for any other grievance/claim, if so desired.

Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed as infructuous with liberty aforementioned.
