Case heard via video conferencing.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'pre-arrest bail' upon FIR No. 64 having been registered at Police Station Sadar, District Gurdaspur, on 24.05.2021, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under the provisions of Section 22 (c) of the NDPS Act, 1985 (with Section 29 of that Act having been added later).

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harjeet Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to the order dated 14.07.2021 and presently his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, the petition has actually been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, he would be given 10 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon him.

Naturally, unless any notice is issued to the petitioner by the respondent-State seeking his custodial interrogation etc., upon any report under the provisions of Section 173 (2) of the Cr.P.C. being submitted to the competent court, that court would admit the petitioner to bail, as per normal process.
