The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to the official respondents No. 2 and 3 for registration of an FIR under Sections 406, 498-A, 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 against private respondents No. 5 to 10.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite representations/complaints having been made to the authorities concerned, no action has been taken by the official respondents. He submits that petitioners would be satisfied if appropriate direction is issued to respondents No.2 and 3 to look into the complaints dated 03.10.2018 and 17.08.2019 (Annexures P-1 and P-3) submitted by her and take appropriate action under the provisions of law.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, Assistant Advocate

General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed by the learned counsel for the petitioner, respondents No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, District Ferozepur, Punjab is directed to look into the complaints of the petitioner representations/complaints dated 03.10.2018 and 17.08.2019 (Annexures P-1 and P-3) and take appropriate steps/action, if any, required under the provisions of law. However, if the respondent No.3 does not find any substance or merit in the allegations levelled by the petitioner, much less, commission of cognizable offences, the petitioner would be duly informed as per the parameters laid down by the apex Court in **Lalita Kumari** Vs. **Government of Uttar Pradesh and Others**; 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
