The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* by directing the respondents to release all the service benefits to the petitioner, i.e. arrears of death cum retirement gratuity and family pension, payment of dues of suspension period, leave encashment, arrears of salary and D.L.I.(Deposit Linked Insurance) alongwith interest @ 9% per annum, for which, legal notice dated 30.06.2021 (Annexure

P-6) has also been served upon the respondents.

In the light of oral submissions of the petitioner side the directions are issued to respondents to duly consider the the legal notice dated 30.06.2021 (Annexure P-6) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.
