Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.50 dated 17.05.2021, under Sections 363, 366-A and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur.

By virtue of the order dated 15.07.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurmail Singh has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioners are no more required for further investigation.
