Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that while making promotion to the post of Assistant Security Officer, the respondents are not adhering to the Reservation Policy dated 15.07.2014, a copy of which has been attached as Annexure P-16 with this writ petition. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the promotions which are being carried out, are in total disregard to the said Reservation Policy, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner. Learned counsel further submits that the said grievance has already been raised by the petitioner with the respondents vide representation dated 01.06.2021 (Annexure P-17) and the petitioner will be

the said representation in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sharad Aggarwal, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and Mr. Anurag Goyal, Advocate, who has also joined the proceedings through video conference, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 2-University. Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No. 2-University raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 01.06.2021 (Annexure P-17) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in representation dated 01.06.2021 (Annexure P-17), respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the representation dated 01.06.2021 (Annexure P-17) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
