The instant petition is filed for quashing of FIR No.0126 dated 12.05.2021 (Annexure P-1) lodged under Sections 363, 366, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code 1860 registered at Police Station Hathin, District Palwal along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same.

Learned counsel submits that the complainant was averse to the relationship between his daughter i.e., the petitioner and one Imtiyaz with whom she subsequently solemnized marriage. After their marriage, both the petitioner and Imtiyaz approached this Court by way of CRWP-4726-2021, for protection of their life and liberty as they were being threatened by the family of the petitioner. Learned counsel further submits that it was in this background, the complainant lodged a false complaint against the husband of the petitioner leading to the registration of case FIR No.0126 dated 12.05.2021 under Sections 363, 366, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code 1860. A prayer has thus been made to quash the aforementioned FIR as it was evident that the petitioner had not been enticed away, much less, kidnapped

by Imtiyaz, as alleged in the FIR in question.

Heard.

A pointed query was put to the learned counsel for the petitioner as to what was her *locus standi* to file the instant petition seeking quashing of the FIR in question, as admittedly she is a victim and not even named as an accused in the FIR in question, however, he miserably failed to satisfy this Court qua the same. Moreover, since the investigation in the FIR in question is still underway, this Court would loathe to exercise its inherent jurisdiction under Section 482 CrPC in the aforementioned facts and circumstances. Resultantly, the instant petition stands dismissed.
