Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner and his family members at the hands of private respondents in pursuance of General Diary No.11 dated 3.7.2020.

Reply by way of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Rural), District Bathinda, is on record and as per the reply, in pursuance of the aforesaid DDR, FIR No.135 dated 3.7.2020 under Sections 341, 323, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Bathinda has been registered. It is also stated in the reply that the opinion of the Medical Board was taken regarding cause of death of the deceased and the operative part is reads as under:-

“So we the Board members are of the opinion that deceased Jagjit Singh was not having any external injury over his body and since no injury has been found at all the levels of examination so that question that the deceased died of injuries does not arise and the person should be considered died of multi organ failure which is one of the natural deaths.

In view of the same, no further action is called for.

This petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach the
Illaqua Magistrate for redressal of his grievances, if any.
