On 14.07.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Petitioner-Karam Singh, stated to be aged 52 years, has filed the present writ petition inter alia praying for quashing the order dated 27.06.2019 (Annexure P-1), order dated 05.06.2020 (Annexure P-2), along with further prayer to direct the respondents to reinstate the petitioner during the pendency of the writ petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset submits that the case of the petitioner is covered by the judgment/order dated 19.05.2021 in CWP No.18508 of 2020 titled as 'Paramjit Singh Vs. State of Punjab and Ors'.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has referred to order dated 13.01.2020, passed in CWP-17929-2008 (Annexure P-4).

On instructions from Mr. Kamalpreet Singh, Civil Suit Clerk O/o SSP, Tarn Taran, learned counsel for the respondents submits that case of the present petitioner is also similar to the petitioner in aforementioned writ petition. She further submits that the respondent-Department is not denying the fact that the present writ petition can be disposed of in terms of the order dated 13.01.2020.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is ***disposed of*** in the same terms as in the order dated 13.01.2020, passed in CWP-17929-2008.
