The petitioner has filed the present (first) petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.202 dated 28.11.2017 registered under Sections 302 and 450 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Ajnala, Amritsar.

Learned State Counsel has submitted that out of 23 prosecution witnesses 22 witnesses have been examined.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner does not want to continue with the present petition and the same may be dismissed as withdrawn

at this stage but the trial Court may be directed to expedite the conclusion of the trial.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.

However, in view of the fact that the FIR was registered in the year 2017, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

A copy of this order be sent to the trial Court concerned for ensuring requisite compliance.
