Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No. 4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the parents of petitioner No. 1 were working as labourers together with respondent No. 4 and when they left for Assam, respondent No. 4 adopted petitioner No. 1. Both the petitioners are major and known to each other for the last more than 2-3 years and now are living in a live-in-relationship against the wishes of respondent No.4. They apprehend danger at the hands of respondent No.4. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated

01.07.2021 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra, but the same has not been decided so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners are living in a constant danger as they have every apprehension that respondent 4 would catch them and carry out his threats and might go to the extent of even committing their murder. The petitioners are, therefore, running from pillar to post for protection of their life and liberty.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners confines his prayer to the extent that the petitioners would be satisfied, if their aforesaid representation is decided by respondent No. 2, within a stipulated period.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 State only.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Ashok Singh Chaudhary, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra, to decide the representation dated 01.07.2021 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioners within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order in accordance with law.
