Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.75 dated 7.06.2021, under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station City Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

By virtue of the order dated 15.07.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
