GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

Petitioner-M/s Jai Ganesh Rice Mills through its Proprietor, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 3 to register petitioner-Firm for the purpose of custom milling of paddy.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, by making reference to the pleadings in the petition, submits that in the year 2020, a writ petition i.e. CWP-13998-2020 titled as Shreel Goyal and another vs. Punjab and Sind Bank and another, was filed before this Court. The petitioner in the said writ petition, namely Shreel Goyal, was borrower of a Firm-M/s National Food Products, Sunam, District Sangrur and challenged the sale notice

dated 06.08.2020 by filing CWP-13998-2020. He submits that the said writ petition has been disposed of vide order dated 23.11.2020. Thereafter, the petitioner submitted an application (Annexure P-10) to respondents No.2 & 3 for its consideration for registration of the firm for custom milling paddy on the ground that registered sale deed has already been executed in its favour on 31.08.2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, submits that he be also permitted to file a supplementary comprehensive representation to the authority concerned.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Ayush Sarna, Assistant AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Without commenting upon merits of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the present writ petition with a direction to the Authority concerned, to decide the application (Annexure P-10) and the supplementary representation, if so submitted, in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of **one month** from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
