The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of DDR No.24 dated 26.10.2014 registered under Sections 323, 325, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Kheri Gandian, District Patiala (Annexure P-1) in FIR No.102 dated 10.11.2014 registered under Sections 325, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the IPC (Charges under Sections 341, 323, 294, 148 and 149 of the IPC) at Police Station Kheri Gandian, District Patiala and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3) effected between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 22.07.2021 passed by the
Coordinate Bench of this Court, the parties appeared before the learned

Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Rajpura to get their statements recorded. Learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Rajpura submitted his report along with copies of statements of the parties vide letter No.1083 dated 01.11.2021 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Patiala vide letter No.7751 dated 02.11.2021.

According to the report, learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Rajpura is satisfied that compromise effected between the parties is genuine, outcome of free consent of the parties and is without coercion from any quarter.

Considering the report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Rajpura dated 01.11.2021 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony between the parties, aforesaid DDR No.24 dated 26.10.2014 (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed, qua the petitioners only.
