The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail in FIR No. 686 dated 16.07.2018 registered under Sections 302, 147, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Sadar Hisar, district Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not press the present petition on its merits and he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Trial Court to finally adjudicate upon the petitioner's trial in a time bound manner.

Learned State counsel submits that he has no objection if the above alternate prayer made on behalf of the petitioner is accepted.

On one hand, the petitioner is an accused of murder; has other criminal cases pending against him and has been convicted for having been declared a proclaimed offender, while on the other hand he has been in

custody for the last over three and a half years with slow progress in his trial.

After considering the totality of the above facts, the above alternate prayer made on behalf of the petitioner is accepted. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Trial Court to finally dispose of the petitioner's trial within ten months from the next date fixed before it in accordance with law, of course, subject to the petitioner's and his counsel's cooperation.
