The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.58 dated 30.01.2021, under Sections 306 and 34 IPC (Section 34 IPC deleted later on), registered at Police Station Meham, District Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is widow of the deceased who had allegedly committed suicide. It is alleged in the FIR that the petitioner had been making complaints against the deceased to the police. He, however, contends that allegations in the FIR do not amount to commission of *prima facie* offence under Section 306 IPC. There is no suicide note which has been left behind. The petitioner is in custody for over 5 ½ months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Sonu, contends that allegations against the petitioner are serious and she is not entitled to the concession of regular bail.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 5 months, the COVID-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
