The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Through this application, the petitioner prays for transfer of the proceedings of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “Gaurav Kanojia Vs. Shalini @ Shanu”, presently pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court-1, Jalandhar to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ambala.

It is not disputed that the petitioner along with her one year old son is residing at Ambala.

The respondent is already defending a proceeding in a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. and is facing trial in a FIR No.664 dated 27.07.2020, at Ambala.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the petition is allowed.

The petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “Gaurav Kanojia Vs. Shalini @ Shanu”, presently pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court-1, Jalandhar, is ordered to be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ambala.

The transferor Court is requested to remit the case file to the transferee Court forthwith.

The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the transferee Court on 21.10.2021.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
